One of the nation's leading urban research universities, Georgia State was founded in 1913 and enrolls a diverse student body of 32,000 while offering 250 degree programs in over 100 fields of study.

Located in downtown Atlanta, the GSU community has grown significantly in the past decade and now houses more than 4,000 students on campus. A state-of-the-art science center serves the science, nursing, health professions and public health programs.

In 2011, the university launched a 10-year strategic plan focused on becoming a national model for undergraduate student success; strengthening graduate and professional programs; addressing 21 st century challenges; understanding and solving the complex challenges of cities; and globalizing the university. GSU is also underway with a five-year plan to add 100 new faculty to enhance scholarly strength and accelerate collaborative research around select themes.
